Dr. Jupiter S. Simbeye is a Senior Lecturer in Statistics in the Mathematical Sciences Department, University of Malawi, where he also serves as Head of Postgraduate Studies. He holds a PhD in Applied Statistics from University College Dublin, Ireland, and MSc degrees in Biostatistics and Applied Statistics from Hasselt University, Belgium.

With over 15 years of experience in statistics training, survey design, and data analysis, he has consulted for organizations including the Global Fund, OECD, Bioversity International, and ICF International (DHS Program), and has worked on World Bank-funded projects as well as initiatives supported by the Wellcome Trust, UNICEF, and IDRC.

He has previously served as Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Science, Head of the Mathematical Sciences Department, Coordinator of the PhD in Biostatistics programme, Senate Representative on the University of Malawi Council, President of the Statistical Association of Malawi, and President of the International Biometric Society's Malawi Region.

His research interests include complex survey design and analysis, generalized linear models, and spatial data analysis with public health applications, particularly HIV/AIDS. He has co-authored numerous peer-reviewed publications and supervised or examined over 50 postgraduate theses across institutions in Africa.
