Prof Tamara Kredo holds the position of Director of the Health Systems Research Unit, South African Medical Research Council.

She is clinical epidemiologist leading research in the field of health policy, evidence synthesis, knowledge translation and clinical guidelines and HTA methods.

She trained as a medical doctor, specialising in Clinical Pharmacology, and completed a PhD in Public Health.

Tamara is dedicated to enhancing credible, transparent evidence-informed healthcare decision-making, particularly in lower resources settings, such as in Africa.

Tamara has fulfilled several leadership roles, including being an appointed members of the South African National Essential Medicines Committee and National Advisory Committee on Immunisation.

She founded the sub-Saharan African regional network, Cochrane Africa in 2017.

Among many highlights, she co-leads the South African GRADE Network; consults to WHO as a methodologist; was a co-opted Trustee of the Guidelines International Network (GIN) Governing Board; she is a member of the GIN working group GINHTA; and in 2020 was elected to the Cochrane Board where she is completing her second term.
